May Minutes:

The minutes of the May Membership meeting were read. Mike Cullen moved to accept the minutes, Ronn Enzweiler seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

Income for the month of May was \$1,091.52, which included a \$500.00 transfer from Morgan-Stanley. Expenses were \$8,616.02. Checking account balance ending September 30, 2024 is \$677.95. Morgan Stanley balance as of September 30, 2024 is \$688,088.15. Ronn Enzweiler moved to accept the report, Lloyd Maple seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Phase Updates:

Kevin Herakovich (Phase 1) recognized Elizabeth Ledyard for more than 100 hours of volunteer work. He noted that Harry Sherman, a PRIDES member from Phase I, has passed away. Kevin said that two of the pine trees in PRIDES' Park and two of the Arbor Day trees are dead. He will talk with the Beautification Committee about replacement. Cheri Marchio (Phase 2) has one new member. She thanked the 20 members of Phase 2 who worked throughout the summer. There was no report from Phase 3.

County Update:

MCDOT personnel have changed over the summer, and Val Bedoe has met with the new supervisor for Sun City. All cacti along 99th south of Peoria have been removed.

Roads & Safety:

Kevin Herakovich attended the September meeting in Cindy Hintze's absence. Fraud is still a big issue in our area, as is speeding.
